This picture displays 3rd graders research lesson of studying Japanese.

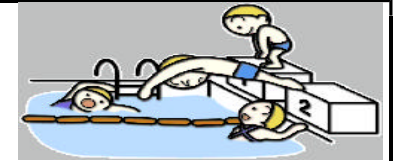

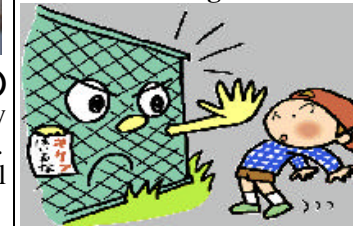
